May 30 (Wed) 8:00 PM - Board Meeting following the Prayer Meeting

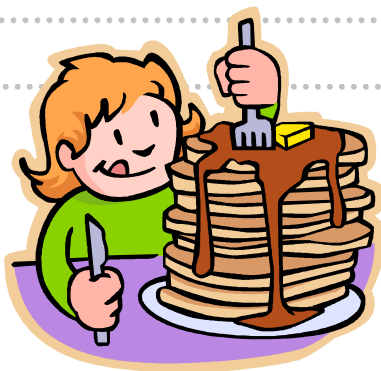
VBS Preparation!
