to make them new. Mostly though I learned that God honors prayers when they will bring honor to His Name.






## My Father's Amazing World - Weird Names part 2




#### Antlion

If the name antlion brings to mind the picture at the top left it's no wonder. But actually both the pictures on the right bottom are the real insect.
